New Clean Up Day Fee

The Town Board has approved a new clean-up day fee effective May 1st, 2016. The reason for the fee is a result of the 2016 clean up days costing over \$18K for Waste Management services of roll off containers. With the same number of participants the fee would generate about \$8K in revenues to help cover the costs. The service is still convenient and much less expensive for residents than taking items to the landfill directly.

Trash & Recycle Rates to Increase Slightly

Our contract with Waste Management has been renewed with a slight increase in rates (2.75%) for 2017. Effective May 1st, the 96 Gallon Container rate will increase 34¢, to \$12.78 per month, and other solid waste disposal costs will increase approximately 2.75%. Recycling will also increase 08¢, to \$3.15 per month. Thank you for your understanding.
