Weeds - Inoperable Vehicles - Trash

Milliken Code Enforcement would like to remind town residents,

- Weeds, Grass & Brush may not be allowed to grow over **6 inches**. Noxious weeds such as Tribulus (goat heads), thistle, cocklebur, bindweed and many more must be removed.
- Inoperable vehicles are not allowed per town nuisance ordinance. Junked, wrecked, dismantled—even partially, on jacks, blocks, etc., unlicensed, lack of proper registration not allowed.
- Trash, Rubbish & Refuse must be removed. We all want to be proud of where we live.
