We're entering the biggest shopping season of the year. Unfortunately, this is also prime season for package thieves. The Milliken Police Department reminds you as you are making online purchases, follow these tips to avoid becoming the victim of package theft.

1. Sign up for delivery alerts so you know when your delivery is scheduled and delivered.
 2. If you are not able to be home when a package is delivered, ask a trusted neighbor to hold it for you.
 3. If possible require a signature for all deliveries.
 4. Consider shipping packages to your work place or the ship to store option.
