SNOW REMOVAL

The Police department would like to remind residents of ordinance 11-1-20. - Snow and ice removal from sidewalks. The owner, occupant, lessee or person in possession or control of any premises or property shall maintain the sidewalks adjoining such premises or property, and shall remove and clear away, or cause to be removed or cleared away, snow and ice from sidewalks in all business districts within the Town by four (4) business hours after the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain or by the beginning hours of the next business day following such fall, whichever period is shorter, and from all other sidewalks in the Town within twenty-four (24) hours of the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain. (Ord. 481 §1, 2003)



Here are some tips to reduce energy consumption and maintain comfortable temperatures in your home this winter:

- Let the sun in those south facing windows
- Bundle up with warm socks and a sweater
- Use ceiling fans to move the heat around
- Lower the thermostat at night
- Only heat the rooms you use
- Keep your furnace filter clean

LATE FEE & RECONNECTION FEE INCREASE JAN. 1, 2017

On December 14, 2016 the Town Board approved new reconnect and late fees for utility bills. As of January 1, 2017 the reconnect fee (after shutoff) for **residential customers will be \$40** on first occurrence. If it occurs again in a 12-month period, **the fee will be \$80** to have the water turned back on. **Commercial reconnect fees are now \$100** per occurrence. **The late fee is now \$8 a month** plus a 1% service charge of the total account balance when the utility bill is not paid on the due date of 5pm on the 24th of each month.
