MILLIKEN POLICE DEPARTMENT

Milliken Police would like to remind citizens about the risks and laws pertaining to leaving a vehicle idling and unattended to warm up; commonly referred to as a "puffer".

Milliken is a very safe community however; we can be targeted by people from outside of our town, which is often the case when it comes to stolen vehicles that are left unattended as a puffer.

Please do not leave your vehicle running and unattended to warm up without first ensuring you have met the minimum requirements for "adequate security measures" and exceptions as outlined in Colorado Revised Statute 42-4-1206. Officers will be patrolling neighborhoods looking for puffers. Warnings will be given when possible but it could also result in a citation. We do not want to see anyone become a victim and have to go through the hardship of a motor vehicle theft. Please contact the police department if you have any questions.

SNOW REMOVAL—YOUR RESPONSIBILITY



Milliken Police department would like to remind residents of ordinance : **11-1-20 Snow & ice removal from sidewalks.** The owner, occupant, lessee or person in possession or control of any premises or property shall maintain the sidewalks adjoining such premises or property, and shall remove and clear away, or cause to be removed or cleared away, snow and ice from sidewalks in all business districts within the Town by four (4) business hours after the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain or by the beginning hours of the next business day following such fall, whichever period is shorter, and from all other sidewalks in the Town within twenty-four (24) hours of the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain.
