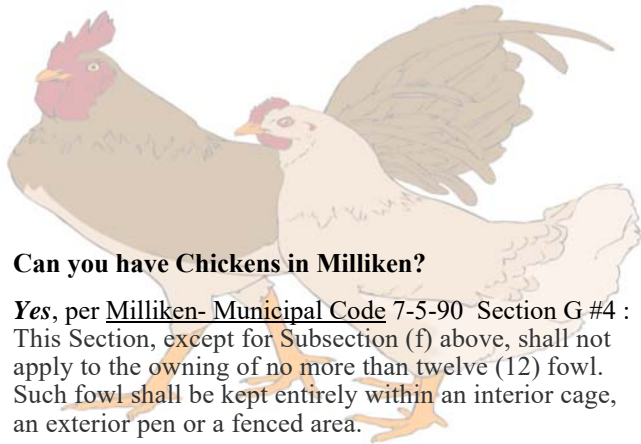
The Commission meets the first and third Wednesdays of each month at 5:30 P.M.

### Can you have Chickens in Milliken?


Yes, per Milliken- Municipal Code 7-5-90 Section G #4 : This Section, except for Subsection (f) above, shall not apply to the owning of no more than twelve (12) fowl. Such fowl shall be kept entirely within an interior cage, an exterior pen or a fenced area.

Get your dog/dogs licensed with the Town.

Please bring a current Rabies Certificate to Town Hall, 1101 Broad St. The cost is \$6. Spayed /Neutered, \$10. if not. You will receive a shiny one year license.



### To Permit or Not to Permit?? (Part I)

Permit requirements for certain construction activities may seem obvious, such as new construction, garages, basement finishes and the like. However, residents may be unaware of the Town's requirements for a fence permit. Fence permits are required for construction of a new fence or replacement of an existing fence in either or both the front or rear yard. The good news is that fence permits are provided at no cost! If you are contemplating replacement, major repair or a new fence, please contact the Community Development Department and we will be happy to assist with your permit application and issuance process.

## NOISE COMPLAINTS



The Police Department is currently seeing a rise in noise complaints; therefore, we would like to remind citizens of the towns noise ordinances. Currently we have two ordinances that pertain to Noise. Sections 10-11-10 and section 10-11-30 which deals with animals.

Under section 10-11-10, No person shall make, continue or cause to be made any excessive or unusually loud noise; or knowingly permit or cause such excessive or unusually loud noise upon any premises; or make, cause or permit excessive or unusually loud noise to emanate from a vehicle owned or possessed by such person or under such person's control or operation.

Under section 10-11-30, It is unlawful for any person to use, keep, have in his or her possession or harbor any domesticated animals which, by frequent or habitual howling, barking, meowing, squawking or otherwise shall cause annoyance or disturbance to persons in the neighborhood.

The officers and code enforcement are required to evaluate several factors including: the source, the time, the zoning of the areas where the noise is made and being heard, and the duration of the noise. If it is determined that a violation exists, a summons may be issued. Let's be courteous and respectful to our neighbors and thank you for helping keep Milliken a safe place to live.
