Garage & Yard Sale Signs



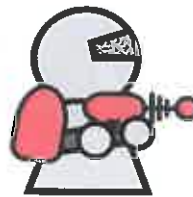
- ◆ Please remember that you can only have a sale twice per month not to exceed three (3) consecutive days.
- ◆ Garage, estate, yard sale or farm auction signs shall NOT be allowed to be posted on stop signs/ street signs/ telephone poles or any other type of pole or fire hydrant.
- ◆ Signs shall be removed within 1 hour after end of sale or by 7:00 pm on the last day of the sale whichever comes first.



As the 4th of July approaches, be aware that Milliken has a **zero tolerance** policy on the possession, use, purchase or sale of any fireworks. This helps keep our kids safe and reduces the fire hazard presented by fireworks.

Just because fireworks are available for sale in other jurisdictions does not legitimize their use within Milliken Town Limits. Please leave the fireworks to the professionals. Police officers will aggressively identify violators who will be cited and fireworks will be confiscated

The Internal Revenue Service is warning consumers of a phone scam targeting taxpayers. Victims are told they owe money to the IRS and it must be paid promptly through a pre-loaded debit card or wire transfer. If the victim refuses to cooperate, they are then threatened with arrest and a warrant issued. If you get a call from someone claiming to be from the IRS, here's what you should do:

- If you know you owe taxes or you think you might owe taxes, call the IRS at 1.800.829.1040. The IRS employees at that line can help you with a payment issue – if there really is such an issue.
- If you've never received a bill or the caller made some bogus threats as described above), report the incident to the [Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration](#) at 1.800.366.4484.
- File a complaint using the [FTC Complaint Assistant](#); choose "Other" and then "Imposter Scams." If the complaint involves someone impersonating the IRS, include the words "IRS Telephone Scam" in the notes.

We advise that you never give out personal information over the phone. Please contact the Milliken Police Dept. (970) 587-2772, if you have further questions or other suspicious phone calls.

CURRENT 2017 WATER RESTRICTIONS

"By Address" - Sprinklers are permitted three (3) times per week One (1) cycle per day Morning OR evening

- Addresses ending in numerals 0, 2, 4, 6 and 8
- Monday, Wednesday and Friday
- 12:01 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. or 7:00 p.m. to midnight
- Addresses ending in numerals 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9
- Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday
- 12:01 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. or 7:00 p.m. to midnight

Hand-watering and drip irrigation is permitted Monday through Sunday with **no restriction**. Hand-watering shall mean holding in the hand a hose with an attached positive shutoff nozzle, or use of a bucket. **Well water** may be used for lawn watering between 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. daily and all day Sunday.
