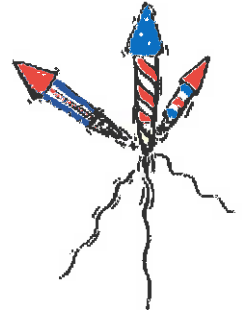


What are your watering days?

If you have new seed or sod, you may pick up a water permit at town hall . The permit will allow you to water unrestricted for 3 weeks.
