Town of Milliken now has a designated parking lot for residents that need semitrailers or truck tractors parking. It is located on the North East corner of Center Drive and WCR 23 3/4. Permits for parking can be obtained at the town hall.



The cost is \$75.00 a quarter or \$250.00 a year. This is not to be used as a storage lot for motorhomes or campers etc. Although Town ordinance does not allow the parking of Semi's in town, we realize the importance of our citizens and over the road truckers need to get rest, family time, a good meal and local parking before getting back on the road again.
