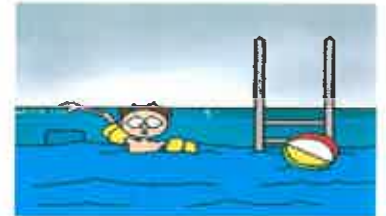
MEMORIAL DAY COMMEMORATION

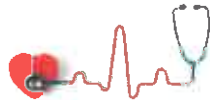

POLICE

Town of Milliken's Animal Ordinances

- 12 fowl are allowed (No Roosters)
 - Dogs are limited to 3 per household
 - All dogs must be vaccinated and licensed with the town
 - Dogs must be on a leash or under the owners immediate control at all times
 - Vicious dogs are prohibited
 - It is prohibited to allow a dog to habitually disturb the neighborhood
 - No dog shall trespass on another's property without permission
 - Tethering of dogs is prohibited unless the use of a trolley system or similar device
 - Loose dogs will be impounded and owners can be fined
- These ordinances are explained in detail and can be found at www.millikenco.gov under "your government" ordinances, Chapter 7, Article V

2017 WATER RESTRICTIONS

"By Address" - Sprinklers are permitted three (3) times per week One (1) cycle per day Morning OR Evening

- Addresses ending in numerals 0, 2, 4, 6 and 8
- Monday, Wednesday and Friday
- 12:01 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. *or* 7:00 p.m. to midnight
- Addresses ending in numerals 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9
- Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday
- 12:01 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. *or* 7:00 p.m. to midnight

Hand-watering and drip irrigation is permitted Monday through Sunday with **no restriction** Hand-watering shall mean holding in the hand a hose with an attached positive shutoff nozzle ,or use of a bucket . **Well water** may be used for lawn watering between 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. daily and all day Sunday. *No automatic sprinkler between November 1-May 1, annually.*

Trash & Recycle Rates to Increase Slightly

Our contract with Waste Management has been renewed with a slight increase in rates (2.75%) for 2017. Effective May 1st, the 96 Gallon Container rate will increase 34¢, to \$12.78 per month, and other solid waste disposal costs will increase approximately 2.75%. Recycling will also increase 08¢, to \$3.15 per month.
