Parking of trailers and recreational vehicles

Please remember that parking of trailers and recreational vehicles on public streets is restricted to 72 hours in 7 consecutive days. Moving a short distance and re-parking does not restart the allowable 72 hours. Having trailers or recreational units hooked up to a vehicle does not exclude these restrictions.

Private property parking is acceptable without limit as long as you are parked on an all-weather surface. (double check with your HOA)

While parked on a public street or alley, overnight accommodations are prohibited. Private property overnight accommodations are limited to 72 hours within a 30-day period. Using campers or trailers for storage or an office is prohibited. Receiving a warning notice is information, not a notice that you have been parked there 72 hours. Parking over 72 hours on a city street may result in a ticket or the vehicle being towed away.

Code enforcement is very flexible for special arrangements.

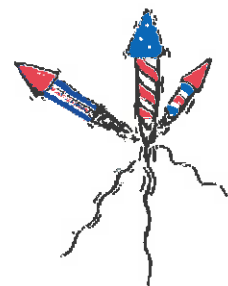
What are your watering days?

If you have new seed or sod, you may pick up a free water permit at town hall. The permit will allow you to water unrestricted for 3 weeks.

Take the "Bite" out of Mosquitoes

The #1 thing you can do to reduce mosquitoes is to eliminate standing water. Mosquitoes go through four stages in their life cycle: egg, larvae, pupa and adult. All but the last stage occur in water. Without water, mosquitoes can't reproduce.



WATER CONSERVATION

Due to the lack of snow pack in the Thompson River Basin this summer's water supply is measuring below normal. Milliken's water suppliers, Greeley and Central Weld, have asked us to be extremely conservative with our outdoor water usage.

Although at this point we are not being required to decrease our watering schedule, we ask that everyone *please be very frugal with your outdoor watering* and continue to pay close attention to our current watering schedule (shown on the front of this newsletter).
