Re: Match Commitment Letter for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) - Hazard Mitigation Program Grant (HMGP) for the Josephine Storm Sewer Improvements Project.

As part of the grant application submitted to FEMA to undertake the project, I do hereby certify that the Town of Milliken is committed to provide the necessary 12.5% project match in the form of cash and/or in-kind contributions up to an amount of \$214,853 as required by the grant application funding request for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. The State of Colorado will also be providing a 12.5% state match up to an amount of \$214,853. The 75% FEMA federal match up to an amount of \$1,289,118. The total cost for the Milliken Drainage Improvements Project is \$1,718,824. The Town will also be applying for a CDGB-DR application in the amount of \$214,853 to cover its 12.5% local share.
