

RESOLUTION NO. 18-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN AWARDING A BID FOR THE SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION TO 1189 SOUTH QUENTINE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR SUCH PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Town of Milliken is authorized under C.R.S. § 31-15-101 to enter into contracts for any lawful municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to enter into a construction contract for the extension of a sewer line to the property located 1189 South Quentine (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Town solicited proposals for the Project in accordance with Colorado law; and

WHEREAS, Town Staff has evaluated the bids received by the deadline and has selected Dan’s Custom Construction Inc., as the lowest responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees, after full consideration of the bids submitted and the recommendation of the Town staff presented to the Board at the March 14, 2018 regular meeting, finds that the proposal submitted by Dan’s Custom Construction, Inc. (the successful bidder, hereinafter the “Contractor”), qualifies that company as the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to award the bid for the Project to the Contractor and authorize the Town Administrator and Town Attorney to finalize the Construction Contract for signature by the Mayor and Contractor; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Town to award the bid for the Project to the Contractor in the not-to-exceed amount of **Thirty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$ 39,800.00)**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Milliken, Colorado that:

Section 1. The Board hereby:

(a) awards the bid for the Sanitary Sewer Extension Project to 1189 South Quentine Project to Dan’s Custom Construction, Inc. in the not-to-exceed amount of Thirty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (**\$ 39,800.00**);

(b) authorizes the Town Administrator and Town Attorney to prepare and finalize a construction contract in a form approved by the Town Attorney; and


(c) authorizes the Mayor to execute the construction contract on behalf of the Town after Contractor has signed the construction contract; and

(d) authorizes the Town Administrator to issue a notice to proceed in accordance with terms and conditions outlined in the project manual and design specifications for the Project.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective upon adoption by the Board.


