This permit will allow residents 3 weeks of unrestricted watering, allowing time for grass to be established. Permits are to be posted in a front window, visible to our Code Officer, from the street. Be conservative, Water is expensive and in shorter supply this year.

### A Word From Code Enforcement

As the summer winds down, there are still many yard sales around town. Please do not post your signs on any light poles, stop signs, street signs etc. Some of you have come up with very creative ways to advertise your sales. Please remember to pick up your signs after your sale is over. **There seems to be some confusion** about the ordinances in Milliken in reference to dogs and cats. Dogs must be under control, by leash or voice command at all times. A dog or cat cannot trespass on anyone's property without permission (this would include urinating or defecating). A dog cannot disturb the neighborhood with constant barking, whining or howling.

The town of Milliken allows 3 dogs per household and all dogs must be licensed. (your pet being licensed could mean the difference between a ride to the Weld County Humane society or just brought back to you).
