The Beef ‘N Bean Day Committee does not carry insurance to cover personal property. As an independent contractor, I understand I am obligated to provide my own insurance for my personal property.

Beef n' Bean Day Official Bean Contest Rules

Time & Location:

- Open for setup at: 2:30pm
- Location for bean drop off: T.R.P.R. 320 Centennial Drive
- Judging time: 3:00pm
- Winners announced: At 4:00pm, T.R.P.R. Stage
- Location & time for crockpot pickup : 5:30pm T.R.P.R. Dinner

General Rules and Regulations:

- Contestants must pre-register in order to enter the contest. You can register at Town Hall with a paper application or on Sign Up Genius. **Registration the day of the contest is not permitted.**
- **NO entry fee.**
- Each contestant must prepare a minimum of one GALLON OF BEANS for judging (a crock pot full).
- Entries are responsible for supplying all cooking utensils and supplies needed, as well as furnishing their own crockpot or hot cooker to keep beans hot.
- There will be electrical hook-ups & extension cords provided.
- A recipe card listing all ingredients **MUST** be present.
- Beans must be covered with a lid when not serving or being judged.
- Participants are allowed to give samples of their beans to other entry participants. However, participants are **NOT** allowed to give samples to the public prior to official judging. In addition, participants are **NOT** allowed to give samples to judges prior to turn in. Any deviation from this rule will result in disqualification of the participants entry.
- Once beans are submitted, you will not have access to it, until judging is completed.

Judging:

- Bean judging will be done using three judges.
- Judges must abstain from inspecting or tasting beans prior to judging. Judges must not be associated with any cook at the cook-off (i.e. one spouse cooking and the other spouse judging).
- Judging criteria and scoring - A single score takes into consideration the five criteria for scoring beans:
 - a) Aroma
 - b) Consistency
 - c) Color
 - d) Taste
 - e) Aftertaste

- Scoring - Each cup of beans will be scored on its own merits with a whole number from 1 to 5, with 5 being the highest.
- Plaque and award given at the T.R.P.R. stage
