PURPOSE

The purpose of this action item is to approve Resolution #16-02 to approve the Weld County 2016 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. The Plan's purpose is to assess and address hazard risks that affect Milliken and Weld County. These risks include winter storms, tornadoes, flooding, summer storms, and etc. The Plan also identifies goals, objectives, and action steps to make Milliken more resilient to future disasters.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Milliken Town staff have attended the required planning meetings, taken on-line surveys, submitted hazard mitigation actions, and have done everything necessary to meet FEMA's local participation requirements. Milliken was a participant in the Northeast Colorado Hazard Mitigation Plan 2009 which expired at the end of 2014. The adoption of the Weld County 2016 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan by the Town of Milliken shall ensure Milliken's Compliance with FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Grant Program until 2021.

SUGGESTED MOTION

"I move to approve Resolution #16-02 authorizing the Town to adopt the Weld County 2016 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. The adoption of the Plan shall ensure the Town of Milliken's compliance with FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the next five years. The Plan also establishes the framework for making Milliken a more disaster resilient community."

RESOLUTION # 16-02

WHEREAS, the Town of Milliken, Colorado, with the assistance from Weld County has gathered information and prepared the Weld County 2016 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Weld County 2016 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has been prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R. 201.6; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Milliken is a local unit of government that has afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input in the Plan and the actions in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees has reviewed the Plan and affirms that the Plan will be updated no less than every five years;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of Trustees that the Town of Milliken adopts the Weld County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, as approved by FEMA, as this jurisdiction's Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, and resolves to execute the actions in the Plan.
