**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this agenda item is to conduct a post award public hearing for a CDBG-DR Round One Planning Grant that the Town received for its Comprehensive Plan and Disaster Resiliency Update 2016. The Total cost for the project was \$80,000. The project was 100% funded through the CDBG-DR Planning Grant Program.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The priority of this project is based on the health, safety, and welfare for the community. The Town was heavily impacted by the 2013 flood event and one of the eight guiding principles identified during the planning process was for Milliken to become “a safer and more disaster resilient community.” The seven other guiding principles of the “2016 Milliken Comprehensive Plan” include: A strong, diversified economic base; A vibrant downtown that functions as the heart of the community; A complete and highly accessible system of parks, open space, trails, and recreational opportunities; A distinct community identity that reflects Milliken’s cultural, archaeological, historic, and agricultural resources; A fiscally sustainable pattern of development; A diverse mix of housing types to meet the needs of residents of all ages, incomes, and abilities; and A well-connected community.

The Planning Commission adopted the Comprehensive Plan through resolution on February 3, 2016 and by the Town Board on February 10, 2016.

The purpose of the Post Award Public Hearing is to give the public a chance to comment on the project as a part of the CDBG-DR’s program requirements.
