Agenda Title: Information Item – Adding road base material to WCR44 from WCR21 to WCR19.			

PURPOSE

To inform the Town Board of project to address the condition of WCR44 between WCR 21 and WCR 19.

BACKGROUND

Over the last few months, a number of complaints have been received on the condition of gravel roads especially after rain or snow storms. Town staff have investigated and reviewed the conditions of all the gravel roads that are the Town's responsibility with particular attention paid to WCR44 between WCR21 and WCR19. As part of the maintenance of this particular section, staff decided that additional material was needed.

As for the road base that is needed to repair the dirt roads the town contacted five (5) Aggregate Companies and the lowest cost received is \$12,000 for the one mile section of WCR44 between WCR21 and WCR19 and to address a couple problem areas between WCR21 and WCR23.

Although this material is only an approximate amount to provide 2 inches of additional material for a 1 mile road section and spots in a second mile, recent road repairs due to the flood cost significantly more to repair gravel road sections.

BUDGET IMPLICATONS

The cost of the aggregate is \$12,000, which is part of the appropriation of the 2015 Budget for street maintenance and repairs for \$349,000.
