



## Milliken Police Department Monthly Report

### Personnel:

- Our Hiring process for the new police officer is now complete. We selected Justin Ellis out of Longmont. He passed all requirements and will begin on May 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Chief Garcia attended the Weld County Chiefs association meeting on the April 15<sup>th</sup>. Held at the Greeley Police Department
- Chief Garcia and Sgt Peters attended the Colorado Department of Transportation Traffic safety meeting held at the Ft Collins Sheriff's office on April 7th. The meeting was to discuss the upcoming 2015 summer safety enforcement campaigns funded through CDOT grant money. Milliken will participate in two campaigns to include the Click it or Ticket and the High Visibility campaigns. This will allow officers to work overtime enforcing Colorado's seat belt and DUI laws.
- A neighborhood watch meeting was conducted by Chief Garcia at the Police station on April 10<sup>th</sup> a second meeting will be conducted later in May.
- Officer King and Officer Tope presented their portfolio which is part of the Police Training Officer program. The portfolio is part of the new officer training program based on problem oriented policing. The officers chose the new skate park as their portfolio, concerning present issues associated with the park, pros and cons and possible solutions.

### Training:

- Chief Garcia attended the Leadership in Police Organizations training held in Greeley from April 20-24.
- Maria Zuniga and Silvia Calvillo attended a State of Colorado Certified notary training on April 21<sup>st</sup> in Ft. Collins.
- Sgt Reiss, Sgt Peters and Officer Isaac Garcia will be attending a leadership training on May 21<sup>st</sup> held at the Loveland Police Department.

### Community Engagement, Community Policing Projects and Community Court:

- The annual Easter Egg Hunt was held April 4<sup>th</sup> at Sappington Park at 10 am. Was a huge success. We had over 400 youth attend to include parents, excellent turn out.

- The Police department received solicitation for the Colorado Rockies Community Ticket program. Every year the Police department has the opportunity to take several youth to the Colorado Rockies game at no cost, tickets are provided to us by the Colorado Rockies.
- The Weld County Food Bank came for the monthly distribution on April 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- Weld County held their health prevention clinic at the town hall on April 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- MYCL, Milliken's Young Community Leaders met on April 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. The Weld WAITS program presented several topics to the MYCL group.
- The Weld County Health Department held the Health Prevention Program on April 22, 2015 at the Milliken Town Hall Community room from 0830am-1200pm.
- Catholic Charities conducted an Immigration presentation held at the Milliken Town Hall on April 26<sup>th</sup>. The presentation was for the community to bring awareness and education on immigration laws.
- Seth Hyberger spoke to the MYCL group on April 28<sup>th</sup>.
- Silvia chaperoned about 30 youth from the Milliken Middle to the Latino Youth Leadership Conference held at UNC.
- There are currently 18 open community court cases. 16 of those cases are active community court participants.
  - There are 4 new cases and 5 cases have been closed.
  - The 4 new cases include 2 truancy, 1 theft and 1 drug distribution
  - 65 hours of useful community service has been ordered.
  - Our next CJC meeting will be held on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.




