PURPOSE

Danielle Jennings of the Burnout Grill has submitted the Renewal Application and paid the required fees to renew the Hotel and Restaurant License for the period of September 14, 2015 until September 14, 2016.

REVIEW CRITERIA COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CODE

This report and the posting of the Town Board meeting Agenda had been prepared in accordance with Municipal Code Sections 6-2-10 through 6-2-40, 6-2-230 and 6-2-310.

6-2-10 Definitions

Retail Licensee or Licensee means the holder of a license to sell fermented malt beverages pursuant to the Colorado Beer Code (Article 46 of Title 12, C.R.S.) or the holder of a license to sell malt, vinous or spirituous liquors pursuant to the Colorado Liquor Code (Article 47 of Title 12, C.R.S.)

6-2-20 Application of State Statutes

Pursuant to declaration by the General Assembly, the Colorado Beer Code, Section 12-46-101 et seq., C.R.S., the Colorado Liquor Code, Section 12-47-101 et seq., C.R.S., as they presently exist or may hereafter be amended, shall apply to the sale of fermented malt beverages, alcoholic beverages, special malt liquors, spirituous liquors and vinous liquors in the Town.

6-2-30 Power and Purpose

The Board of Trustees finds and determines that it is empowered by Section 12-47-135, C.R.S., to fix and collect certain fees in connection with the application for issuance, transfer and renewal of certain types of beer, wine and liquor licenses. The Board of Trustees, further finds that the fees established in this Article are reasonable and are in amounts sufficient to cover actual and necessary expenses incurred by the Town in connection with the handling of such licenses and applications.

6-2-40 Licensing Fees

The fees for licensing are set forth in the Fee Schedule and shall be paid to the Town Clerk by the applicant at the time of the filing of the application or request.

6-2-230 Occupation Tax

In addition to any other applicable fees, every applicant for a news license or renewal of an existing license pursuant to the Division shall pay the annual occupation tax as set forth in the Fee Schedule.

6-2-310 Purpose

Considering the nature of the business of selling malt, vinous or spirituous liquors or fermented malt beverage and the relation of such business to the municipal welfare, as well as the relation thereof to the expenditures required by the Town and a proper, just and equitable distribution of the tax burdens within the Town and all other matters properly to be considered in relation thereto, the classification of such business as a separate occupation is reasonable, proper, uniform and non-discriminating and necessary for a just and proper distribution of tax burdens within the Town.

BACKGROUND

The Renewal Application is required annually by the Colorado Department of Revenue. The application appears to be in compliance with the Town of Milliken's requirements and the Colorado Department of Revenue. There had nineteen (19) Police Calls for service since their last license renewal. The prior year there had been thirty-six (36) calls for service. Generally, the calls for service are initiated by the establishment.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Not applicable.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Board of Trustees renew the Hotel and Restaurant License for Burnout Grill at 1760 Broad Street, Unit A Milliken, Colorado.
