**PURPOSE**

The purpose is to adopt the Town of Milliken Trail & Sidewalk Gap Analysis prepared by Lamp Rynearson & Associates.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This report was one portion of the Kaiser Foundation Walk and Wheel Grant that the Town received in April 2014. Also included were a community trail survey about new trails and existing trail needs as well as the design work for the initial portion of the Milliken Johnstown trail segment. The Trail & Sidewalk Gap Analysis was budgeted at \$23,500.

In 2003, the towns of Milliken and Johnstown collaborated to establish a Trail Master Plan that identified future trail locations. The 2003 Trail Master Plan included a proposed trail that would connect the two towns, now being referred to as the Milliken-Johnstown Trail. Since the Trail Master Plan creation there are several additional events that occurred:

2008 – Milliken Transportation Master Plan

2010 – Milliken Comprehensive Plan Update was adopted and included the Milliken-Johnstown trail as a priority.

2013 – Kaiser Permanente awards a \$100,000 grant through its Walk & Wheel program.

2013 – CDOT awards the Town (through NFRMPO) \$300,000 for construction of a portion of the Milliken-Johnstown Trail.

2014-2015 – Town residents were surveyed by Transformative Alliances. The survey gathered input related to trail development within the Town.

2015 – Gap Analysis Report identifies eight recommendations for trail system connectivity.

The eight projects identified include

- 1) Quentine Avenue from Windmill Gateway to Broad St.
- 2) Alice Avenue at the Union Pacific RR crossing
- 3) Broad Street East at the Union Pacific RR crossing
- 4) Green Street from Marjorie Avenue to Irene Avenue.
- 5) Settlers Village from Alice Avenue to Traders Lane
- 6) Broad Street West from Kathleen Avenue to Josephine Avenue.
- 7) Inez Blvd. at the Union Pacific RR crossing
- 8) Quentine/Inez Blvd. from Lilac St. to Dove Valley Lane.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Town Staff recommends approval of the Trail & Sidewalk Gap Analysis report.
