

KEEP MILLIKEN BEAUTIFUL ADOPT-A-STREET PROGRAM
AGREEMENT AND PERMIT

Keep Milliken Beautiful (hereinafter "KMB"), The Town of Milliken (hereinafter "Town") and _____, (hereinafter the "Entity") recognize the need and the desirability of litter-free and visually-improved streets.

The **Adopt-A-Street** program has been established for community and civic organizations as well as private businesses and industry to contribute toward the effort of maintaining cleaner and more beautiful streets in the Town of Milliken. The purpose of the Keep Milliken Beautiful **Adopt-A-Street** program is to encourage community residents and organizations to adopt residential blocks of streets and keep them litter-free. The adopted areas are to be cleaned **every 2 months** in an effort to maintain a healthy environment and to produce feelings of pride in our beautiful town.

The Entity understands that the work to be performed can result in physical injury or damage to property and agrees to assume the risk. The Entity hereby agrees to release and hold harmless Keep Milliken Beautiful and the Town of Milliken, and any neighborhood committee, their officers, employees and agents respectively from liability for any and all claims, damages or injuries of any kind or nature which the Entity, its employees, members or agents may cause or suffer as a result of participation in the program. Each participant will complete and sign a Risk-Acknowledgement and Individual Liability Release in order to participate in the program.

Keep Milliken Beautiful and the Town of Milliken shall place signs at each end of the adopted blocks of streets recognizing the adopting Entity.

The Entity volunteers are to pick up litter at least **every 2 months** (more if necessary) along its section of street for a period beginning _____, and ending _____. **Contract commitment is for 2 years minimum.**

The Entity may cancel this agreement upon 30 days written notice to the Town of Milliken Public Works Director.

Items provided for clean-up are: Clean-up reports (to be turned in after clean-up), safety vests and trash bags. **If safety vests are misplaced, the group will be responsible for their replacement.**

*****All participants must attend a pre-work Safety Meeting scheduled by Milliken Public Works*****

**** Items collected by Adopt-A-Street participants should be litter and debris that can fit into trash bags provided. Large items that will not fit into trash bags should be placed in piles along the cleaned area out of the way of both pedestrian and motor vehicle traffic. Bags and debris should not be placed in the road or sidewalks. Bags of recyclable materials should be in separate bags and in separate piles. The Adopt-A-Street contact person should call Milliken Public Works at 970-587-8723 the following working day to report when a cleanup has been conducted.
