What is the Adopt-A-Street Program?

The Adopt-A-Street Program is a litter reduction campaign designed to remove litter and debris from Town of Milliken Streets and improve the quality of our environment. The program offers individuals, groups and businesses the opportunity to demonstrate their desire for a cleaner community by taking responsibility for streets, which they can help beautify and keep litter free.

Who can participate?

Any individual, group or business has the opportunity to get involved

What Streets can be adopted?

KMB and the Town have pre-selected a number of streets around town that represent our highest litter areas.

Hurry, locations are limited!



How does the program work?

You can help in the effort to keep Milliken clean.

You will be removing litter and debris, which is hazardous to people and the environment, from a Milliken street.

This program is designed to be easy and fun!

It works like this:

Commit and pledge for a minimum of one year to collect litter and debris on your adopted street at least 6 times per year. You will be recognized for your volunteer efforts on the KMB/Town website, in a newsletter and have two Adopt-A-Street signs installed in your name, like the example below:



Participation Commitment

Partners in the Adopt-A-Street Program must fill out an application form, which can be acquired from the Town of Milliken, Public Works Department located at 2951 Ash Street or on the Town website www.town.milliken.co.us

Partners are expected to clean their adopted area as required by their commitment.

Partners have the opportunity in contributing to the effort of making our community litter free!



Keep Milliken Beautiful and the Town of Milliken's Commitment

The Town will assist you in selecting your street.

Provide safety training, trash bags, safety equipment at no cost.

Provide bags and haul away the bagged litter, and all heavy debris or hazardous objects.

Recognize your achievement according to the commitment that you make.
