

**NOTICE OF REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
MAIL BALLOT ELECTION  
TOWN OF MILLIKEN  
APRIL 3, 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Milliken will hold its regular municipal election for the purpose of electing four members of the Board of Trustees; three for four-year terms and one for a two-year term on **Tuesday, April 3, 2018**. The election will be held as a mail-ballot election. All Registered Voters will receive a mail ballot shortly after March 12, 2018. Ballots may be dropped off at the Milliken Town Hall, 1101 Broad Street, Milliken, Colorado 80543, March 12, 2018 – April 2, 2018, Monday-Friday 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM and 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM on Election Day, Tuesday, April 3, 2018.

In order to be eligible to vote in this election, a person must be 18 years old, a citizen of the United States, a resident of the Town of Milliken at least 22 days preceding the date of election and be registered to vote in the Town of Milliken.

At said election, the electors of the Town of Milliken shall vote for the following candidate(s) and two (2) Ballot Questions:

**BALLOT QUESTION 1A:**

SHALL THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN SALES AND USE TAX OF 0.50% (ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT) CURRENTLY IMPOSED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 457 OF THE TOWN AND SCHEDULED TO TERMINATE UPON PAYMENT OF THE TOWN'S OUTSTANDING SALES AND USE TAX REVENUES BONDS BE EXTENDED IN PERPETUITY; SHALL THE REVENUES FROM THE EXTENDED TAX CONTINUE TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE TOWN'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND, UPON PAYMENT OF THE OUTSTANDING REVENUE BONDS, USED TO ACQUIRE, CONSTRUCT, REPAIR AND IMPROVE TOWN CAPITAL ASSETS AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES; SHALL APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN CODE BE AMENDED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES CONSISTENT WITH THIS BALLOT ISSUE; AND SHALL THE REVENUES FROM THE EXTENDED SALES AND USE TAX AND THE EARNINGS ON SUCH REVENUES (REGARDLESS OF AMOUNT) CONSTITUTE A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE?

**BALLOT QUESTION 1B:**

SHALL THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN BE AUTHORIZED TO PUBLISH ORDINANCES BY TITLE ONLY RATHER THAN BY PUBLISHING EACH ORDINANCE IN FULL, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 31-16-105, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, THEREBY SUBSTANTIALLY REDUCING THE COST INCURRED IN THE PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES, WITH SUCH PUBLICATION TO INCLUDE A STATEMENT THAT "THE

COMPLETE TEXT OF ALL ORDINANCES IS AVAILABLE AT THE TOWN OFFICES AND  
ON THE TOWN'S OFFICIAL WEBSITE?

Completed ballots must be returned in the envelopes provided. Ballots returned by US Mail must have adequate postage affixed. Voters must sign and date the return envelope; if this information is not complete, the ballot will not be counted.

Any voter needing a replacement ballot may come to the Town Clerk's office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, through April 2, 2018, or between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on April 3, 2018 and obtain said ballot.

Any voter who will be absent from his/her residence during the mailing period for ballots may contact the Town Clerk at 1101 Broad Street, Milliken, CO between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, to make application for an alternate mailing address. Application must be made no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 30, 2018.
