**COLORADO TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM
APPLICATION SPONSORSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Town of Milliken desires assistance from the Colorado Department of Transportation's Transportation Alternatives Grant Program for the purpose of constructing the South HWY 60, West Alice Avenue, and Inez Boulevard Pedestrian Railroad Crossings and Trail Improvements Project, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board hereby commits to the continued maintenance of the South HWY 60, West Alice, and Inez Boulevard Pedestrian Railroad Crossings and Trail Improvements Project once constructed, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board commits to the \$109,419 local match for the project with a total project cost of \$547,093, and

WHEREAS, the project meets all local zoning, planning regulations, and ordinances, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board and Staff acknowledges its responsibility to secure rights-of-way or easements for construction;

BE IT RESOLVED the Town Board hereby authorizes the filing of a grant application, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, for the Colorado Transportation Alternatives Program, and hereby authorizes the Mayor to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.
