TRASH RATES TO INCREASE

Our contract with Waste Management has been renewed with a slight increase in rates (2.75%) for 2016. Effective May 1st, the 96 Gallon Container rate will increase \$.29, to \$12.44 per month, and other solid waste disposal costs will increase approximately 2.75%. Recycling will also increase \$.32, to \$3.07 per month.
