SOLICITORS

The Town of Milliken adopted a Door-to-Door Solicitation ordinance (Sec: 6-2-200) that requires all solicitors to obtain a license and an identification badge issued by the Town before going door to door in Milliken. If a resident is approached by a solicitor, the solicitor is required to have the identification badge visible and to be shown upon the request of the resident. There are times when solicitors may become aggressive, and be without a license or engaged in criminal activity. The Police Department takes these violations seriously and the safety of our residents is important to us. Therefore, we would ask that if you are approached by a solicitor you believe is unlicensed, fails to show you the license identification, badge identification or you feel that this person is acting suspicious in any way, please contact the Police immediately at (970) 587-2772.
