SPOTLIGHT FOR JUNE

GARAGE/YARD SIGNS

Please remember that you can only have a sale twice per month not to exceed three (3) consecutive days. Garage, estate, yard sale or farm auction signs shall **NOT** be allowed to be posted on stop signs/ street signs/ telephone poles or any other type of pole or fire hydrant. Signs shall be removed within 1 hour after end of sale or by 7:00 pm on the last day of the sale whichever comes first.
