Tuesday, May 31, **Milliken Pool Opens**

The intent of this designation is to permit water sprinkling up to three (3) times per week and one (1) cycle per day, either in the morning hours or the evening hours allotted.

1. Addresses ending in numerals 0, 2, 4, 6 and 8 shall be allowed sprinkling of lawns every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 12:01 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. or from 7:00 p.m. to 12:00 midnight only.
2. Addresses ending in numerals 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 shall be allowed sprinkling of lawns every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 12:01 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. or from 7:00 p.m. to 12:00 midnight only.
3. Hand-watering and drip irrigation shall be permitted Monday through Sunday and not be restricted by the above-mentioned lawn-sprinkling restrictions. Hand-watering shall mean holding in the hand a hose with an attached positive shutoff nozzle or a bucket and does not include operating a hose with a sprinkler or manually operating an irrigation controller.
4. Town-treated water shall not be used for lawn sprinkler irrigation between 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. daily and all day on Sunday.
5. No automatic sprinkler irrigation shall occur between November 1 and May 1 of each calendar year.

CLEAN-UP DAY - SATURDAY, May 14, 2016

Spring Clean-Up Day will be Saturday, May 14, 2016 from 8:00am to 2:00pm at the northeast corner of Center Dr and CR 23 ^{3/4} (East of Town on HWY 60 then take your first left hand turn lane to Road 23 ^{3/4})

Clean-Up Day provides the residents of the community an opportunity to dispose of items from their home and property at no cost. Metal recycling drop-off will also be available.

NON ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: TV's, Ammunition, Medical Equipment, Asbestos, Medications, Asphalt, Dirt, Concrete, Sod, Tires, Rocks, Gas Cans, Construction Material, Any unit or device with sludge or Household Hazardous Waste. If you are unsure of other special materials call Town Hall before Saturday.
