Improvements Coming to Centennial Park!

This Fall you will start to notice improvements around Centennial Park to make it a better place. The Town's Capital Improvement Fund helps cover costs for any park improvement. The funds for these improvements are apart of the 2016 budget.

Additions coming to Centennial Park include a Performance Shelter, new playground, and a concrete trail around the lake. Hall Irwin Corporation donated Lake and Fishing sculptures that will be placed near the lake.
