WORD FROM THE MAYOR

Previously known as Bean Day, Milliken's first annual Beef 'N Bean day was held Saturday, August 7, 1971. Sponsors for the event were Milliken businessmen, the Town of Milliken, the Johnstown-Milliken Lions Club, and several residents of the area.

Festivities began in the afternoon with a pet and doll parade. Numerous game and concessions stands were open during the afternoon including horseshoe pitching contests and card games.

A carnival of eight rides was located on the school parking lot Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.

The barbecue was held in Lola park from 5 to 7 P.M with barbecue sandwiches, baked beans, potato chips, and drinks serving over a thousand people. Approximately 350 pounds of beef was donated along with beans and other side dishes. A dance at the firehouse for all ages ended the day. **

The Beef and Bean day to be held in a few weeks (August 8) will be similar to the original. It still retains the small town flavor of a community gathering with local folks volunteering, organizing, donating, and enjoying themselves.

I invite each and every one of you to attend and enjoy at least one of the events from the early morning pancake breakfast by the Front Range Fire Rescue Authority to the evening fireworks.
