Message from the Mayor:

The Town Board is actively engaged in the process to hire a permanent Town Administrator. With recommendations from both the Colorado Municipal League (CML) and Department of Local Affairs (DOLA), we have been through the preliminary steps. These include identifying the goals, strategies, and challenges of the Town. Identifying the traits, characteristics, qualities, and skill sets of the manager has been accomplished. We have engaged an executive search firm who specializes in recruiting nationally and assessing well-qualified candidates for the position of Town Administrator. The firm is experienced in selecting highly qualified individuals who meet the profile and needs of the Town as well as having resources to contact those in their pool who might not otherwise apply. The Board also sought one additional guarantee, that if the appointee leaves for any reason within 24 months of appointment, no additional fees will be paid to repeat the entire search process. We anticipate having the Town Administrator on board by the first of September. We are fortunate the interim Administrator, Cheryl Powell, has been with the Town for a number of years and has overall knowledge of the issues confronting us. This was important in our decision to have her serve as interim rather than seeking an outside consultant for a four to six month period. Additionally, she has appointed the former Commander Garcia as acting police chief. That position requires a more management oriented skillset. With additional training, experience, and assistance from other police chiefs and peers within Northern Colorado, we anticipate that he will fulfill the Chief position and focus on public safety within our town. You are welcome to contact them for any issues you may have concerning the town.

Residents may water three days per week under the following schedule: Addresses ending in an even number, 0,2,4,6,8 may water on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 12:01 am to 9:00am and 7:00pm to 12midnight. Addresses ending in an odd number, 1,3,5,7,9 may water on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, 12:01am to 9:00am and 7:00pm to 12midnight.

Automatic sprinklers are NOT permitted on Sunday.
