CLEAN-UP DAY - SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2014

The Town of Milliken will conduct Fall Clean-Up Day on Saturday, Oct 11, 2014 from 8:00am to 2:00pm at the Public Works Facility located at 2951 Ash Street, east of Town on HWY 60 (first left hand turn lane) to Road 23½. Turn left (north) to the drop site. Clean-Up Day provides the residents of the community an opportunity to dispose of items from their home and property at no cost. Metal recycling and household hazardous waste drop-off will also be available. **NON ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:** Ammunition, Medical Equipment, Asbestos, Medications, Asphalt, Dirt, Concrete, Sod, Tires, Rocks, Gas, Propane can, Construction Material, Any unit or device with sludge or Liquids. If you are unsure of other special materials call Town Hall before Saturday.
